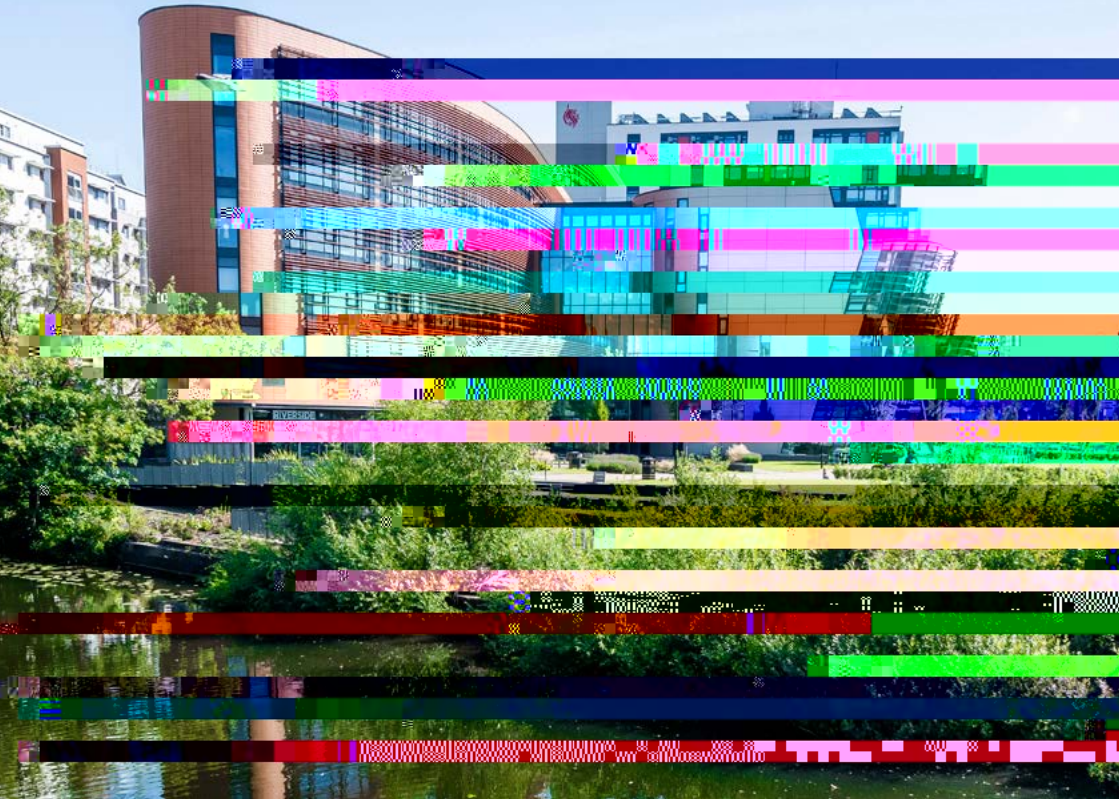

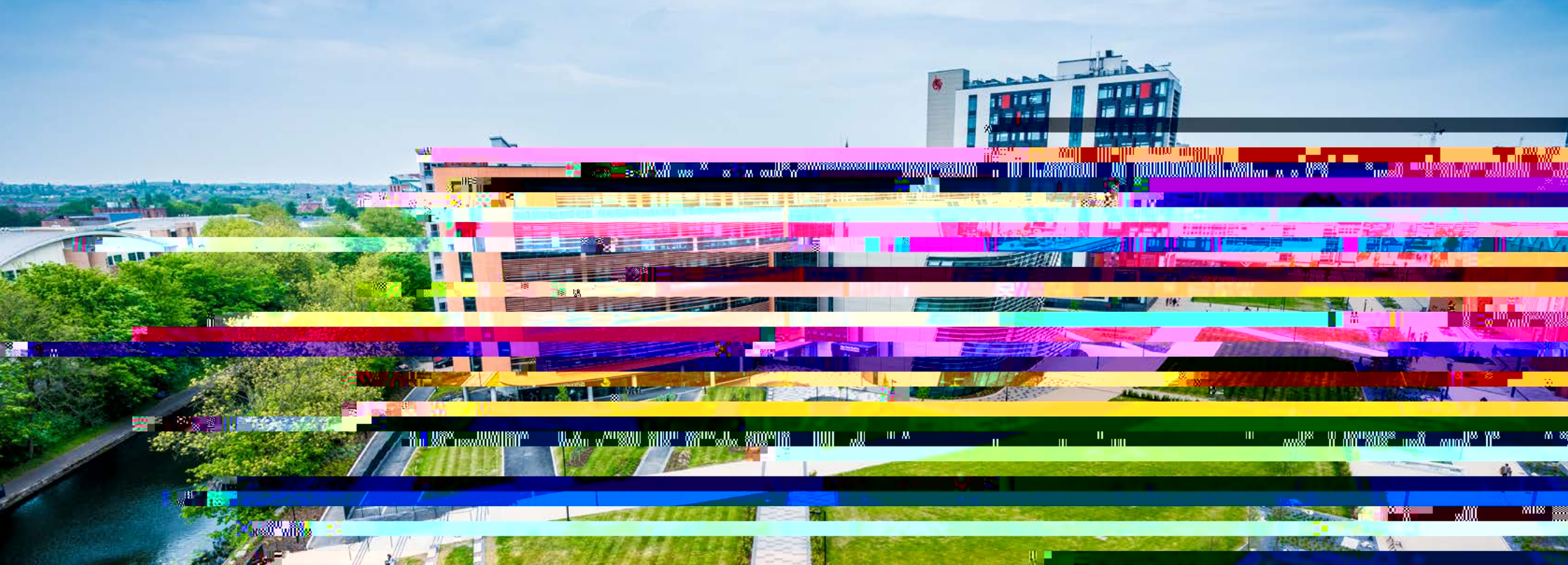

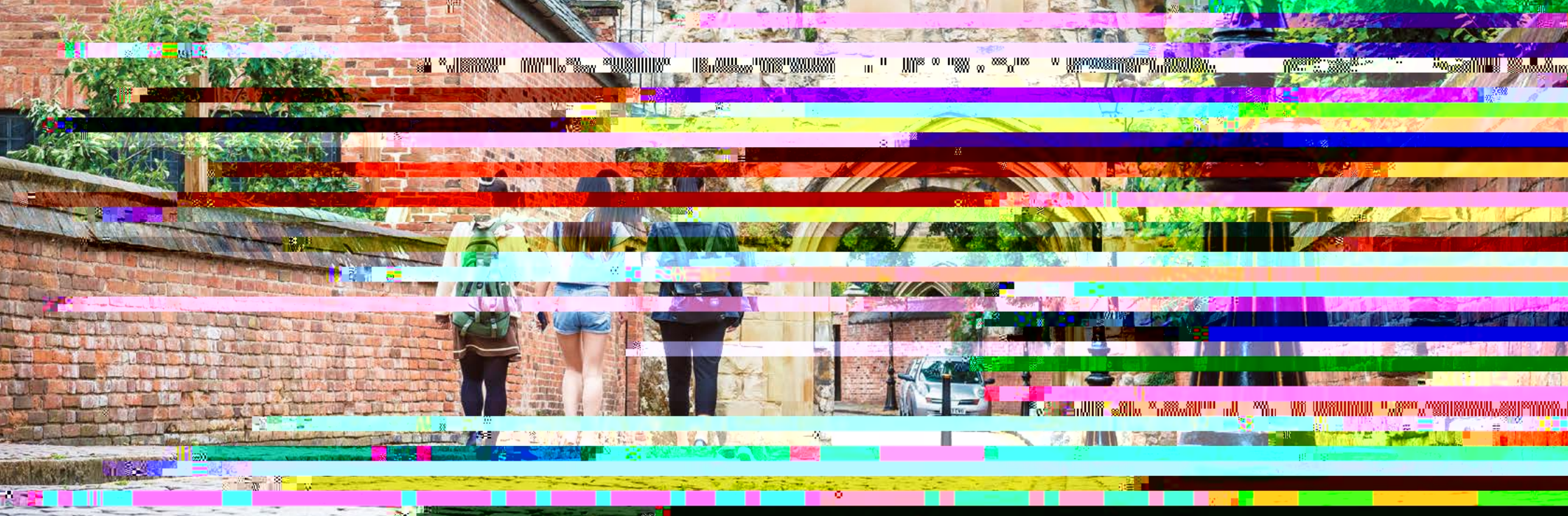
UBER/TAXI
